A Starting Point

Anne is a **mother of five** living in Kilgoris, Kenya. After her husband was imprisoned, she became **solely responsible for supporting her family** under extremely difficult circumstances.

Determined to change her future, Anne joined the **Women's Table Banking program**, implemented by Dupoto Flourish Africa in partnership with the GO Fund. Through small, consistent monthly savings, she **built financial discipline** and trust within her group.

After two years, Anne qualified for a loan of **KES 15,000 (approximately \$115 USD)** and made a simple but powerful decision.

She used the loan to purchase a **gas-powered grass cutter** for her son.

What Changed

- Her son started a grass-cutting business
- He earned enough to purchase a 2nd machine
- A second job was created
- Household income increased
- The family began planning for the future
